

CERTIFICATE 3 GUARANTEE STUDENT FACT SHEET



WHAT IS THE CERTIFICATE 3 GUARANTEE?

The Certificate 3 Guarantee supports eligible individuals to complete their first post-school certificate III level qualification and increase their skills to move into employment, re-enter the workforce or advance their career. Funding under the Certificate 3 Guarantee Program is provided by the Queensland Department of Employment, Small Business and Training.

STUDENT CO-CONTRIBUTION FEE

As part of the Certificate 3 Guarantee Program a student co-contribution fee must be collected. This fee can be paid by the student themselves or on behalf of the student by a third party. The applicable fee is paid upon enrolment and prior to commencement of training and is the final & only fee the student must pay. The fees payable are outlined in the table below.

Co-contribution fees are not payable for units that are awarded a Credit Transfer. If you are awarded a Credit Transfer, you will be refunded the co-contribution fee paid for that unit.

17 units of Competency

- 11 core units
- 6 elective units

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AHC30921 - CERTIFICATE III IN LANDSCAPE CONSTRUCTION

- 14 elective units

AHC32816 - CERTIFICATE III IN RURAL OPERATIONS

This qualification is designed to meet the needs of a Horticulturalist working in operations on rural projects. To achieve this qualification, the candidate must demonstrate competency in:

16 units of Competency

- 2 core units
- 14 elective units

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Students that undertake this course under the Certificate 3 Guarantee Program will no longer be eligible for a government subsidised training place for the program.

ELIGIBILITY

To assist in confirming eligibility the RTO will:

1. Conduct an AISS Search to confirm any of my previous study; and
2. Obtain information from any RTO in relation to prior enrolment in any qualification/course

Students will be offered RPL at the first trainer visit and will also negotiate the electives for the qualification at this time.
